



Crumbling Roads

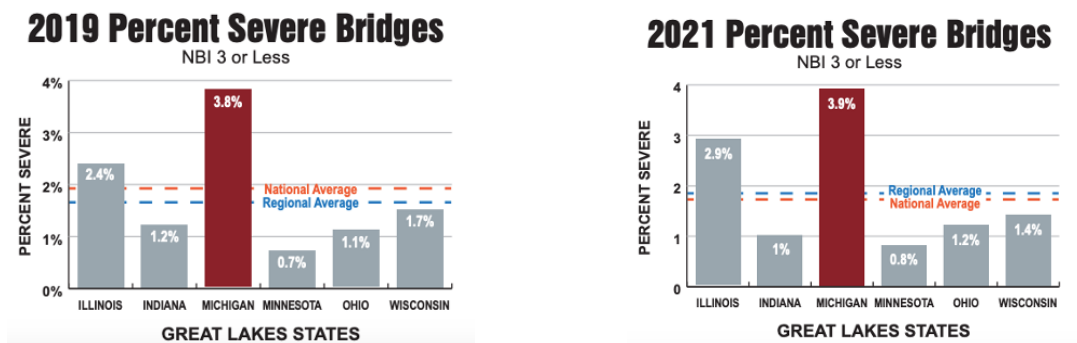
It's no surprise that Michigan has crumbling roads, and has been ranked as the eighth worst state to drive in.

Michigan Continues To Remain One Of The Worst States To Drive In

- “A recent study by WalletHub ranked The Mitten as one of the worst states for driving. ... Michigan is the eight worst state to drive in, according to the study.”

From 2019 To 2021, The Number Of Bridges In Michigan Considered To Be In Severe Condition, Thus Requiring Immediate Action Or Being At Risk Of Closure, Increased

- From 2019 To 2021, The Percentage Of Michigan's Bridges Classified As Being In “Severe” Condition Increased
- Bridges In “Severe” Condition Require Additional Monitoring, Immediate Action, Or Risk Closure
- “More concerning, when measuring the bridges in Severe Condition, or those requiring additional monitoring, immediate action, or at risk of closure, Michigan has double the percentage of bridges with NBI ratings of 3 or less.”
